Section 1. Section 2-15-3502, MCA, is amended to read:
"2-15-3502. Board of environmental review. (1) There is a board of environmental review.
(2) The board consists of seven members appointed by the governor. The members must be representative of the geographic areas of the state. One-member must have-expertise-or background in hydrology. One member must have expertise or background in loeal government planning. One member must have-expertise of background in one of the environmental-seienees. One member must have-expertise-of background as a county health officer or as a medieal doctor. In selecting the members, the governor shall choose one member with expertise or background:
(a) in hydrology;
(b) in one of the environmental sciences;
(c) as a county health officer or as a medical doctor;
(d) in agriculture;
(e) in oil and gas development;
(f) in electrical energy generation; and
(g) in hard-rock or coal mining.
(3) A vacancy occurring on the board must be filled by the governor in the same manner and from the same representative area as the original appointment.
(4) The board is designated as a quasi-judicial board for purposes of 2-15-124.
(5) The board is attached to the department of environmental quality for administrative purposes only as provided in 2-15-121."
