9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Use of state money for funding litigation prohibited without voter
12	approval penalty. (1) The board of trustees of a school district receiving state money may not expend that
13	money to directly or indirectly support litigation to obtain additional state funding without prior voter approval.
14	(2) If a legislative audit determines that the trustees of a school district have expended state funds in
15	violation of this section, the superintendent of public instruction shall withhold from the district in the succeeding
16	fiscal year a payment of state funds that is equal to that spent without voter approval.
17	
18	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
19	integral part of Title 20, chapter 3, part 3, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter 3, part 3, apply to [section 1].
20	
21	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
22	
23	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Termination. [This act] terminates June 30, 2013.
