4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CREATING THE OFFENSE OF CRIMINAL DESTRUCTION OF OR
5	TAMPERING WITH A COMMUNICATION DEVICE; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES."

7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Criminal destruction of or tampering with communication device. (1)
10	A person commits the offense of criminal destruction of or tampering with a communication device if before,
11	during, or after the commission of a criminal offense, the person purposely or knowingly destroys or tampers with
12	a telephone or other communication device that is capable of contacting law enforcement or medical assistance
13	TO OBSTRUCT, PREVENT, OR INTERFERE WITH:
14	(A) THE REPORT TO ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF ANY ACTUAL CRIMINAL OFFENSE;
15	(B) THE REPORT TO ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF ANY ACTUAL BODILY INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE;
16	OR
17	(C) A REQUEST MADE TO ANY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR TO ANY HOSPITAL, DOCTOR, OR OTHER MEDICAL
18	PROVIDER FOR NECESSARY AMBULANCE OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.
19	(2) A person destroys or tampers with a communication device by making the communication device
20	unusable or inoperable, by interrupting its use, or by making it inaccessible.
21	(3) (a) A person convicted of the offense of criminal destruction of or tampering with a communication
22	device before, during, or after the commission of a misdemeanor shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$1,000
23	or imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months, or both.
24	(b) A person convicted of the offense of criminal destruction of or tampering with a communication device
25	before, during, or after the commission of a felony shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$50,000 or imprisoned
26	in the state prison for a term not to exceed 10 years, or both.

28	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
29	integral part of Title 45, chapter 6, part 1, and the provisions of Title 45, chapter 6, part 1, apply to [section 1].
