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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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12	Section 1. Section 15-30-305, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"15-30-305. Department rules <u> conformance with Internal Revenue Code</u> . <u>(1)</u> The department is
14	hereby authorized to make such may adopt rules and to may require such facts and information to be reported
15	as it may deem considers necessary to enforce the provisions of this chapter.
16	(2) In this chapter, a term has the same meaning as it does when used in a comparable context in the
17	Internal Revenue Code, unless a different meaning is clearly required or unless the term is specifically defined
18	in this chapter. Insofar as is practicable in the administration of this chapter, the department shall apply and follow
19	the administrative and judicial interpretations of the Internal Revenue Code. When a provision of the Internal
20	Revenue Code is the subject of conflicting opinions by two or more federal courts, the department shall follow
21	the rule observed by the United States commissioner of internal revenue until the conflict is resolved.

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25	Section 2. Section 15-31-501, MCA, is amended to read:
26	"15-31-501. Department rules conformance with Internal Revenue Code. (1) The department of
27	revenue shall have power to prescribe forms for returns and notices and such other regulations as may from time
28	to time be found necessary for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this chapter.
29	(2) In this chapter, a term has the same meaning as it does when used in a comparable context in the
30	Internal Revenue Code, unless a different meaning is clearly required or unless the term is specifically defined

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1	in this chapter. Insofar as is practicable in the administration of this chapter, the department shall apply and follow
2	the administrative and judicial interpretations of the Internal Revenue Code. When a provision of the Internal
3	Revenue Code is the subject of conflicting opinions by two or more federal courts, the department shall follow
4	the rule observed by the United States commissioner of internal revenue until the conflict is resolved.
