9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Review of proposed rule by governor's office. (1) Before an agency files
12	a notice of its intended action with the secretary of state pursuant to 2-4-302(2), the governor's office shall review
13	the proposed rule for consistency with the administration's policies.
14	(2) This section does not apply to a rule proposed pursuant to 2-4-303 or 2-4-315 or to a rule proposed
15	by the department of justice, secretary of state, superintendent of public instruction, or state auditor.

17	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
18	integral part of Title 2, chapter 4, part 3, and the provisions of Title 2, chapter 4, part 3, apply to [section 1].

20	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
