11	<b>"53-4-1005. (Temporary) Benefits provided.</b> (1) Benefits provided to participants in the program may
12	include but are not limited to:
13	(a)(1) inpatient and outpatient hospital services;
14	(b)(2) physician and advanced practice registered nurse services;
15	(c)(3) laboratory and x-ray services;
16	(d)(4) well-child and well-baby services;
17	(e)(5) immunizations;
18	(f)(6) clinic services;
19	( <del>g)</del> (7) dental services;
20	(h)(8) prescription drugs;
21	(i)(9) mental health and substance abuse treatment services;
22	<del>(j)</del> (10) hearing and vision exams; and
23	<del>(k)<u>(11)</u> eyeglasses.</del>
24	(2) The department is specifically prohibited from providing payment for birth control contraceptives
25	under this program. (Terminates on occurrence of contingencysec. 15, Ch. 571, L. 1999.)"

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
