4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING A \$300 \$100 INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR
5	QUALIFIED VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS; PROVIDING
6	QUALIFICATIONS TO CLAIM THE CREDIT; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND A
7	RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY DATE."
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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Credit for volunteer firefighters. (1) There is a credit against the taxes
12	imposed by 15-30-103 in an amount of 300 for a qualified volunteer firefighter <u>ORA VOLUNTEER EMERGENCY</u>
13	MEDICAL TECHNICIAN.
14	(2) To be entitled to the credit authorized in subsection (1), a taxpayer, during the state fiscal year that
15	ends in the tax year for which the credit is claimed, must have:
16	(a) been a volunteer firefighter as defined in 39-71-118 <u>OR AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN AS DEFINED</u>
17	<u>IN 50-6-202;</u>
18	(b) been an active, nonpaid member during the entire fiscal year of the same volunteer fire company
19	organized under the provisions of Title 7, chapter 33, part 21, 22, 23, or 24, OR THE SAME VOLUNTEER EMERGENCY
20	MEDICAL SERVICE AS DEFINED IN 50-6-302; and
21	(c) completed a minimum of 30 hours of training as specified in 19-17-108(3) FOR FIREFIGHTERS OR
22	COMPLETED THE NUMBER OF TRAINING HOURS PRESCRIBED BY THE MONTANA STATE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS FOR
23	EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS.
24	(3) A taxpayer claiming the credit allowed by this section shall provide, on forms provided by the
25	department, evidence that the taxpayer has been an active member of the same volunteer fire company ENTITY
26	during the entire fiscal year REFERRED TO IN SUBSECTION (2)(A) and has participated in the training referred to in
27	subsection (2)(c).
28	(4) The credit allowed under this section may not exceed the taxpayer's income tax liability, and there
29	is no carryback or carryforward of the credit permitted under this section.
30	(5) A TAXPAYER MAY NOT CLAIM A CREDIT AS BOTH A FIREFIGHTER AND AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
integral part of Title 15, chapter 30, and the provisions of Title 15, chapter 30, apply to [section 1].
NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
NEW SECTION. Section 4. Retroactive applicability. [This act] applies retroactively, within the
meaning of 1-2-109, to tax years beginning after December 31, 2006.
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
