LFD Page B-94, DP 70005 - Newborn Screening Follow-Up Program - This request is for \$145,000 in FY 2008 and \$290,000 in FY 2009 in Tobacco Trust Fund Interest (SSR) to support a comprehensive newborn screening follow-up program to assure the availability of appropriate clinical diagnostic and support services for families and primary care providers of those babies identified with an abnormal condition from the expanded panel of newborn screening tests. This program will be administered by the Children with Special Health Services Section of the Family and Community Health Bureau. By January 1, 2009, the program will expand by administrative rule the panel of conditions for which Montana tests to 28 and a hearing screening and will establish contract(s) for follow-up services. Follow-up services will be provided beginning January 1, 2009. If Senate Bill 162 is passed by the 2007 Montana Legislature, this funding would be used for its implementation.
