Explanation - This amendment reduces state special revenue by \$352,039 in FY08 and \$357,047 in FY09 (biennial reduction of \$709,086) and reduces federal special revenue by \$136,396 in FY08 and \$107,805 in FY09 (biennial reduction of \$244,201) in the Remediation Division of the Department of Environmental Quality to reduce base operating authority in response to a change in the funding of abandoned mine lands program.
