Insert: "(2) The department or its agent may not require a driver who may be in violation of this section to stop at any time from one-half hour after sunrise to one-half hour before sunset except upon reasonable cause that the driver has violated another traffic regulation or that the driver's vehicle is unsafe or not equipped as required by law.

(3) There is no penalty for violation of this section during the time period of one-half hour after sunrise to one-half hour before sunset, and the penalties proscribed in 61-9-511 do not apply to this section if the violation occurs during the time period of one-half hour after sunrise to one-half hour before sunset."
