(1) (a) Except as provided in subsection (1) (b), a rental vehicle entity that rents a rental vehicle equipped with a global positioning system or a satellite navigation system to a person in this state shall disclose in the rental agreement the presence and purpose of the system.

(b) A rental vehicle entity that uses event data recorders only to track lost or stolen vehicles or provide navigational services is not required to provide the disclosure in subsection (1) (a).

(2) As used in this section:

(a) "rental agreement" means a written agreement setting forth the terms and conditions governing the use of a rental vehicle that is provided by a rental vehicle entity for the rental of a rental vehicle for a period of not more than 90 days;

(b) "rental vehicle" means a light vehicle, a motorcycle, a motor-driven cycle, a quadricycle, a motorboat, a sailboat, or an off-highway vehicle, any of which is used under a rental agreement by a person other than the owner of the vehicle;

(c) "rental vehicle entity" means a business entity that




