Commissioner of Political Practices:

1. There will be no significant impact assuming ethics complaints will continue to be rare. Commissioner of Political Practices (CPP) receives very few ethics complaints—only seven in the last six years. The caveat is that if ethics complaints are prompted by passage of HB 86, costs to the CPP could become relatively high, depending on: 1) the complexity of legal issues, 2) whether there are extensive pre-hearing proceedings (such as dispositive motions) and, 3) the length of the hearing and the post-hearing activities, such as briefing.
