



AN ACT CLARIFYING CERTAIN RULEMAKING AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; REMOVING THE REFERENCE TO THE OBSOLETE SINGLE-STATE REGISTRATION SYSTEM; CLARIFYING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MAY ADOPT RULES RELATED TO COOPERATIVE OR RECIPROCAL AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER STATES; AMENDING SECTION 61-3-710, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-3-710, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-3-710. Rulemaking authority. The department of transportation may adopt and enforce rules for the administration of ~~the single-state registration system~~ cooperative or reciprocal vehicle registration, including the setting of a fee, and for other matters necessary to carry out the provisions of 61-3-708 and 61-3-709."

Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
