A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT EXPANDING THE EXEMPTION FROM INSPECTIONS, INSPECTION FEES, CERTIFICATES, AND OPERATOR LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR STEAM HEATING BOILERS AND HOT WATER HEATING OR SUPPLY BOILERS; AND AMENDING SECTION 50-74-103, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 50-74-103, MCA, is amended to read:

"50-74-103. Boilers exempted. (1) This chapter ~~shall~~ does not apply to boilers under federal control.

(2) The provisions of this chapter requiring inspections, inspection fees, and certificates ~~shall do~~ do not apply to:

(A) ~~steam heating boilers operated at not over 15 pounds per square inch gauge pressure in private residences or apartments of six or less families~~ IN PRIVATE RESIDENCES OR APARTMENTS OF SIX OR FEWER FAMILIES or to hot water heating or supply boilers operated at not over 50 pounds per square inch gauge pressure and temperatures not over 250 degrees F ~~when in private residences or apartments of six or less families~~ IN PRIVATE RESIDENCES OR APARTMENTS OF SIX OR FEWER FAMILIES; OR

(B) A STEAM HEATING BOILER OPERATED AT NOT OVER 15 POUNDS PER SQUARE INCH GAUGE PRESSURE IN A COMMERCIAL BUILDING OR TO A HOT WATER HEATING OR SUPPLY BOILER OPERATED AT NOT OVER 30 POUNDS PER SQUARE INCH GAUGE PRESSURE AND TEMPERATURES NOT OVER 190 DEGREES F IN A COMMERCIAL BUILDING WHEN THE BOILER IS THE SOLE BOILER OF THAT TYPE IN THE COMMERCIAL BUILDING AND IS OPERATED AND MAINTAINED BY THE OWNER.

(3) ~~No persons~~ A person operating any of the engines or boilers exempted from the operation of this chapter ~~shall be~~ is not required to procure a license from the department."
