HB 130 -

Establishing a state grant program to help counties develop local mental health crisis intervention and stabilization services and jail diversion programs

Amendment HB013002.ash

- Changes the grant program from a reimbursement to counties "after the fact" to a grant program that provides funding up front based on a grant application detailing how the county intends to spend the money
- Clarifies that the grant program does not require state and local funding to match
- Strikes the language that the state grant may be for up to 75% of what the county spent
- Requires each county to include in its grant application an explanation of how the county and other local entities will collaborate and commit local funds
- Adds language to ensure that in awarding the grants, the DPHHS will consider whether the county plan is likely to reduce admissions to the state hospital and save state money
- Adds "short-term inpatient treatment" to the type of services for which the grant money may be used
- Adds "multicounty" language to clarify that counties may collaborate to develop a regional (i.e. multicounty) strategic plan
- Allows the DPHHS a little more time to adopt rules and implement the program
- Strikes language that requires certain expenses to be considered "eligible" for reimbursement; this is needed because the program is no longer a reimbursement program
- Inserts a new section (Section 5) that is a coordination instruction so that if HB 645, the stimulus bill, contains a line item appropriation for a "community mental health crisis services demonstration project" which encompasses the purposes of this bill, then the appropriation section of this HB 130 is void. This is needed to ensure there will not be two appropriations for the same thing.
