




DENTAL SERVICES IN HEALTH CENTERS 2001-2007





General Dentist Statistics

- US population to General Practice dentists - 1,813:1 (2007 ADA Data)
- Montana population to General Practice dentists - 2,157:1 (2007 ADA Data)
- 2007 MT population 957,861/1,813 = 528 dentists to achieve national ratio
- In 2007, there were 444 General Practice dentists in Montana (2007 ADA Data)
- $528 - 444 = 84$
- Montana needs approximately 84 more General Practice dentists to equal the national ratio.
