Mr. Chairman, We have just finished up here at the office. We will have the list of projects for the commission to pair down close to the stimulus dollar total that MDT is expecting to get. Should be finished up early in the AM. All the projects have already been approved through the environmental process with the majority of work completed. Almost all the projects have future letting dates already approved by the commission through the tentative construction schedule and will be moving up do to stimulus funding. Some projects may have design work still to complete and R/W to purchase. The process to get to this point will be discussed under agenda item 1. This discussion should be very informative to the committee. We will be asking the commission to approve a list larger then the stimulus dollars we will receive. MDT will then go to work with the list and work out the timing and obstacles that some projects may have to meet the critical timelines. We will then offer to the commission a revised list that closely represent the amount of the stimulus. Get at least one more look from everyone. 
