Bobby Lane's Testimony on Senate Bill 406

Heard before the House Judiciary Committee 3/26/09

Between two consenting , fertile adults, the chance of pregnancy from an act of intercourse is 3% or 3 in 100. In the case of rape, there are factors involved that lower that chance of pregnancy to 1 in 1000.

In 2007, there were 319 reported cases of rape in Montana. Based on these numbers, it would take more than 3 years for one case of pregnancy from rape.

Rape and incest, as reasons given for abortion, amount to less than 1% of abortions. If the opposition brings up pregnancy from rape, know that is totally irrelevant to this bill.

I urge you to vote YES on Senate Bill 406.
