It is the intent of the Montana Association of Counties to support proposed legislation created by the HB 49 Interim Study Committee

WHEREAS, the Montana Association of Counties adopted MACo Resolution 2006-2 that sought legislation in 2007 to authorize an interim study of special purpose district statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Legislature passed House Bill 49 that authorized such a study; and

WHEREAS, the interim committee charged with conducting a study included local government representation; and

WHEREAS, the committee has proposed legislation to reflect the findings and recommendations of the study to provide uniformity and flexibility in the creation, administration, funding, alteration and dissolution of many special purpose districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Montana Association shall support the recommended findings and legislation proposed by the interim study.
