RESOLUTION 2008 - 26

OBSOLETE STATUTES

It is the intent of the Montana Association of Counties to support legislation to amend or repeal archaic or obsolete local government statutes.

WHEREAS, the office of Legislative Services identified several Montana local government statutes that they viewed as being obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the office of Legislative Services requested MACo's assistance in locating other similar statutes that are archaic or outdated ; and

WHEREAS, MACo distributed this request to county elected officials and staff conducted a thorough review of county related statutes and submitted a report to legislative services containing recommendation ; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Education and Local Government Committee has approved, as a committee bill proposed legislation to amend or repeal many archaic or obsolete local government statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Montana Association of Counties support legislation to amend or repeal archaic or outdated local government statutes.
