Explanation - This amendment funds costs to implement HB 658, a bill to mitigate impacts of the recent property tax reappraisal. The amendment adds contingency language to void the appropriation if HB 658 fails to become law. It also adds \$1,587,053 general fund for the 2011 biennium to the Property Assessment Division of the Department of Revenue to fund the addition of 9.30 FTE and associated operating costs to implement the bill.
