4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING A PERSON OPERATING A RETAIL BUSINESS FOR
5 THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE PREMISES TO OPERATE A
6 CAMERA TO PHOTOGRAPH PERSONS ENTERING AND LEAVING THE LICENSED PREMISES; REQUIRING
7 THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO ADOPT RULES; AND PROVIDING A DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Retail licensees to operate cameras -- rulemaking -- penalty.** (1) During
12 the hours when a retail licensee offers alcoholic beverages for sale, the licensee must have in operation a camera
13 that photographs all individuals entering and leaving the licensed premises.

14 (2) The department shall adopt rules to implement this section, including rules specifying the location
15 and resolution capability of the camera and the length of time that photographs taken by a camera required by
16 this section must be maintained by the licensee.

17 (3) Failure to comply with this section or rules adopted pursuant to this section is punishable as provided
18 in Title 16, chapter 6, part 3.

20 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
21 integral part of Title 16, chapter 3, part 3, and the provisions of Title 16, chapter 3, part 3, apply to [section 1].

23 NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective October 1, 2012.
