

1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5

4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5 MONTANA URGING CONGRESS TO CALL A CONVENTION FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF PROPOSING
6 AN AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE TERM LIMITS FOR MEMBERS
7 OF CONGRESS.

9 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution provides that upon the application of the
10 legislatures of two-thirds of the states, Congress shall call a convention for proposing amendments; and

11 WHEREAS, the Legislature of Montana deems an amendment for the United States Constitution requiring
12 term limits for members of Congress necessary for the good of the American people.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15 STATE OF MONTANA:

16 That the Legislature of the State of Montana makes application to the Congress under the provisions of
17 Article V of the United States Constitution to call a convention for the sole purpose of proposing an amendment
18 to the United States Constitution regarding term limits for members of Congress.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be dispatched to the Majority Leader of the
20 United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, to the Secretaries of the
21 United States and Montana Senates, to the Clerks of the United States and Montana Houses of Representatives,
22 to each member of the Montana congressional delegation, and to the presiding officers of each house of the
23 Legislature of each state in the Union requesting their cooperation.
