Explanation - High Cost Support. This amendment restores \$563,466 total funds over the biennium (\$369,632 general fund) for the 5% reduction item for children in the foster care or subsidized adoption that are in need of intensive, high cost support. The amendment would fund a \$40 increase to the present provider rate reduction of \$60 a day to \$20 a day. It increases general fund by \$184,816 each year of the biennium, state special revenue by 32,400 each year, and federal revenue by 64,517 each year for these services.
