Explanation - This amendment is the HB 10 recommendation of the Long-Range Planning (LRP) Subcommittee to the House Appropriations Committee.

This amendment combines two actions of the LRP subcommittee.

- 1) (A technical amendment) The LRP subcommittee recommends correcting the transfer of Long-Range Information Technology Program (LRITP) funds to the general fund to match the amount of the project reductions included in HB 10. The subcommittee voted unanimously reduce the general fund transfer by \$240.
- 2) The LRP subcommittee agreed in a unanimous vote to reduce the transfer of LRITP funds to the general fund by \$5,975,000 to provide money for the LEG branch IT project, to be appropriated in HB 5.
- 3) The transfer of LRITP included in HB 10 as introduced is \$10,737,273.
- 4)  $\$10,737,273 - \$240 - \$5,975,000 = \$4,762,033$
