11 **NEW SECTION. Section 1. Right of employee to keep firearm in motor vehicle.** (1) An employer
12 may not, by contract or otherwise, prohibit an employee from keeping a firearm that is locked in the trunk of the
13 employee's motor vehicle or is out of view inside the employee's locked motor vehicle when the vehicle is parked
14 at the employee's workplace. S. Champion Edmund Sam Keith

- 15 (2) For the purposes of subsection (1), "locked motor vehicle" means:
16 (a) a truck or hard top automobile with the windows rolled up and the doors locked; or
17 (b) a convertible with the windows rolled up, the top up and secured, and the doors locked. Christy
