1. Page 10, line 4.

**Strike:** "(3)"

**Insert:** "(5)"

2. Page 10, line 13.

**Following:** "~~parole.~~"

**Insert:** "placement in an appropriate correctional facility or program for a term of 13 months. The court shall order that if the person successfully completes a residential alcohol treatment program operated or approved by the department of corrections, the remainder of the 13-month sentence must be served on probation. The imposition or execution of the 13-month sentence may not be deferred or suspended, and the person is not eligible for parole."

3. Page 10, line 15.

**Strike:** "a term" through "years"

4. Page 10, line 16 through line 17.

**Strike:** "; and" on line 16 through "\$10,000." on line 17

**Insert:** "(b) sentencing the person to either the department of corrections or the Montana state prison or Montana women's prison for a term of not more than 5 years, all of which must be suspended, to run consecutively to the term imposed under subsection (1)(a); and

(c) a fine in an amount of not less than \$1,000 or more than \$10,000."
