A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROHIBITING A LEGISLATOR FROM BEING EMPLOYED BY ~~LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT,~~ THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, OR ANOTHER STATE AGENCY WHILE IN OFFICE; PROHIBITING A LEGISLATOR FROM SERVING AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR TO ~~A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT,~~ THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, OR ANOTHER STATE AGENCY WHILE IN OFFICE; REQUIRING A CURRENT LEGISLATOR EMPLOYED BY OR SERVING AS AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR TO ~~A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT,~~ THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, OR ANOTHER STATE AGENCY TO RESIGN FROM THE LEGISLATURE; AMENDING SECTION 2-2-111, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-2-111, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-2-111. Rules of conduct for legislators. Proof of commission of any act enumerated in this section is proof that the legislator committing the act has breached the legislator's public duty. A legislator may not:

(1) accept a fee, contingent fee, or any other compensation, except the official compensation provided by statute, for promoting or opposing the passage of legislation;

(2) seek other employment for the legislator or solicit a contract for the legislator's services by the use of the office; or

(3) accept a fee or other compensation, except as provided for in 5-2-302, from a Montana state agency or a political subdivision of the state of Montana for speaking to the agency or political subdivision;

(4) be employed by a local government, the federal government, the judicial branch, or a state agency other than the legislature during the legislator's term in office; or

(5) accept a position as an independent contractor to a local government, the federal government, the judicial branch, or state agency other than the legislature during the legislator's term in office."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Resignation from legislature -- termination of government



1 **employment.** A legislator who is employed as provided in 2-2-111(4) or (5) on or after [the effective date of this
2 act] shall either resign from the legislature or terminate the government employment.

4 NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.

6 NEW SECTION. **Section 4. Applicability.** [This act] applies to a legislator who is employed as provided
7 in 2-2-111(4) or (5) on or before [the effective date of this act].
