



Protecting Wildlife for our children's future



MONTANA VOTERS (N=400)
February 23-24, 2011

The survey was conducted February 23-24, 2011 by Moore Information, Inc. a national public opinion research company. Telephone interviews were conducted among a representative sample of 400 registered voters statewide. Random Digit Dialing and probability sampling methods were used to select potential respondents, and respondents were screened to include only those who are registered to vote in the State. The potential sampling error associated with the 400 statewide interviews is +/-5% at the 95% confidence level. This means that if the survey were conducted 100 times, the results would fall within that plus or minus range 95 of the 100 times.

As you may know, wild populations of bison used to roam throughout all of eastern Montana but now wild populations occur only in and around Yellowstone National Park.
