

Dear Senator,

Workers' compensation in Montana is broken. According to a 50-state study of workers' compensation costs, Montana had the highest premiums in the country. Our neighbors, on the other hand, have some of the most affordable premiums in the country. This puts Montana at a competitive disadvantage, brings our wage levels down for workers, and makes it difficult to attract new businesses to our state.

Fortunately, the Legislature sees the need to pass major workers' compensation reforms during this session. HB 334 (Reichner – Bigfork) is a bill that addresses the main cost drivers of our system through claim closure, claim settlements, course and scope of employment revisions, adoption of utilization and treatment guidelines, stay-at-work/return-to-work programs and more. Based on projections from the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI), HB 334 will provide both short-term and long-term savings for Montana employers, which would be helpful in getting our economy back on track.
