SB 44 "Raise Age for School Enrollment"

A bill for an Act entitled: "An Act revising the conditions for exemption from compulsory school enrollment and attendance; providing exceptions from compulsory enrollment and attendance for certain students; amending Sections 20-5-102 and 20-5-103, MCA and providing an effective date."

SB 44 would increase the compulsory age in Montana from 16 to 18, graduation from high school, or receipt of a GED as the time when a student may leave school.

A significant impact of expanding the compulsory attendance age would be an inevitable tax increase to pay for more classroom space and teachers to accommodate the additional students compelled to attend public school. For this reason, SB44 should be defeated.

I strongly oppose SB44 and do not want to see it become Montana Law.
