Explanation - This amendment restores funding for the 5% reduction item "9% Reduction Physician and Anesthesia RBRVS", which lowered Medicaid physician reimbursement rates to the Medicare rate. This item was submitted as part of the 5% reduction plan as required by statute, but this item was not included in the executive budget request. It was adopted as part of the budget starting point.

This amendment adds the following amounts:
 general fund - \$1,667,829 each year of the biennium for a total of \$3,335,658 and
 federal Medicaid matching funds - \$3,265,117 in FY 2012 and \$3,200,323 in FY 2013 for a total of \$6,465,440
