Explanation - This amendment reverses action taken in the Health and Human Services Joint Appropriation Subcommittee that reduced appropriations for lower enrollment growth for Healthy Montana Kids for children in families with incomes above 100% of the federal poverty level.

The subcommittee used the state special revenue to offset general fund costs for lower income children enrolled in Healthy Montana Kids. In order to restore the state special revenue this amendment adds general fund to reverse the offset and it reinstates the federal matching funds.

This amendment adds the following amounts:

general fund - \$503,266 in FY 2012 and \$356,366 in FY 2013 for a total of \$859,632
federal children's health insurance program (CHIP) grant funding - \$1,629,218 in FY 2012 and \$1,131,591 in FY 2013 for a total of \$2,760,809
