Explanation - This amendment removes \$29.1 million from the Health Resources Division. This funding is the amount reallocated from tobacco settlement funds to increase the amount allocated to the Healthy Montana Kids Program. An appropriation for this amount will be included in another bill.

This amendment reduces:
 state special revenue by \$5,089,451 in FY 2012 and \$4,815,718 in FY 2013 for a total of \$9,905,169 and
 federal Medicaid matching funds by \$9,963,643 in FY 2012 and \$9,240,668 in FY 2013 for a total of \$19,204,311
