Explanation - These amendments add \$476,536 of state special revenue authority in FY 2012 and \$490,075 of state special revenue authority in FY 2013 to the Montana Historical Society, contingent upon passage and approval of HB 477. The state special revenue is the lodging facility use tax and the funds are intended to be used for historical interpretation and Scriver collection costs.

HB 477 establishes a state special revenue account for the Montana Historical Society for costs associated with historical

interpretation and the Robert Scriver collection and funds the account with revenue from the lodging facility use tax. The special revenue account would be available to the Montana Historical Society by appropriation.
