Following: line 13**Insert:** "(2) (a) If a student scholarship organization receives more applications for scholarships than it is able to award using available scholarship funds, students that are awarded 90% of the scholarships under this section must be chosen using a random selection process. If the student scholarship organization has applicants who have previously received support from the student scholarship organization or who are siblings of students already receiving a scholarship from the student scholarship organization, they may be awarded a scholarship without submitting to the random selection process.

(b) The remaining 10% of available scholarship grants may be awarded at the discretion of the student scholarship organization based on an applicant's financial or personal hardship.

(c) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) (a), a student scholarship organization may grant scholarships to any number of students in any amount."
