My name is Doug Carpenter. I live in Helena Montana.

I say NO to this bill for the following reasons:

- 1) This is a direct infringement on our rights under the 4th Amendment.
- 2) If this is such a good law for Montana, why has it been turned down five times previously? How come only 28 states have passed it during the past 10-12 years.
- 3) Passage of this bill could possibly result in the state receiving a large amount of Federal Funds if a grant is approved. At this point we have no idea what is in the grant application plus it is also subject to the availability of funds. So all this bill guarantees is that the state is in compliance with Federal regulation. This is a ploy from Federal Government to attract us to possibly feed at the federal "TROUGH" for exchanging our rights.
- 4) I have worked at a University Hospital/Medical School writing several grants for Federal Funds and have witnessed the strings that are attached to one-time grants from the Federal Government and how they compromise local control.

This is not good legislation for Montana.
