**Following:** "dying." on line 2

**Strike:** remainder of line 2 through "suicide." on line 4

**Insert:** "Aid in dying means the provision of an agent capable of causing death to a victim by any means for the intended purpose of causing the victim's death, including physician-assisted suicide, assisted suicide, euthanasia, and mercy killing. The provision of palliative care under the Montana Rights of the Terminally Ill Act, Title 50, chapter 9, and other medical care that does not have the intended purpose of causing the patient's death is not aid in dying, physician-assisted suicide, assisted suicide, euthanasia, or mercy killing."

2. Page 2, line 24.

**Following:** "euthanasia"

**Insert:** ", physician-assisted suicide"
