Dallas Erickson Testimony

Mr. Chair and Members of the Committee,

I remember in the 1980s a book called OUR BODIES OURSELVES was being introduced into the schools. One of the principles taught in the book was that all types of perverted homosexual activity was normal and on a par with heterosexual sex.
