RE: Bill Conflict Requiring Your Attention

There is a conflict between:

\* **HB 631** (Menahan --GENERALLY REVISE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS ON IGNITION INTERLOCK REQUIREMENTS) -- Scheduled for hearing in Senate Judiciary Committee 4/12/11

and

\* **HB 102** (Menahan -- REVISE PROBATIONARY DRIVER'S LICENSE PROVISIONS FOR DUI COURT PARTICIPATION -- By Request of the Law and Justice Interim Committee) **Signed by the Governor 4/08/11.**

Both bills amend the 61-2-302 and 61-5-208, MCA, in a manner that conflicts. These bills need to be coordinated in some way--either through an amendment to one or more of the bills to make the language in the bills work together or by a coordination instruction. If more than one bill passes as they are drafted, the amendments made by the bills to the MCA section are in conflict and cannot be codified into a coherent whole.
