11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13	Section 1. Section 2-3-212, MCA, is amended to read:
14	"2-3-212. Minutes of meetings public inspection. (1) Appropriate minutes of all meetings required
15	by 2-3-203 to be open shall must be kept and shall must be available for inspection by the public. If an official
16	audio recording of a meeting is made AND DESIGNATED AS OFFICIAL, the recording constitutes the official record
17	of the meeting. If an official recording is made, a written record of the meeting must also be made and must
18	include the information specified in subsection (2).
19	(2) Such minutes shall Minutes must include without limitation:
20	(a) the date, time, and place of the meeting;
21	(b) a list of the individual members of the public body, agency, or organization who were in attendance
22	(c) the substance of all matters proposed, discussed, or decided; and AND
23	(d) at the request of any member, a record <u>of votes</u> by individual members of <u>for</u> any votes taken <u>; and</u>
24	(e) if(3) If the minutes are recorded AND DESIGNATED AS THE OFFICIAL RECORD, a log or time stamp for
25	each MAIN agenda item IS REQUIRED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCESSING THAT
26	PORTION OF THE MEETING."
