18	1979 by enactment of Chapter 683, Laws of 1979, and the terms for which currently run from January 2005 to			
19	January 2013. There will be no election for these	positions in the general e	election to be held in November 2012.

21	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Saving cla	use. [This act] does not	affect rights and duties that matured,	
22	penalties that were incurred, or proceedings that were begun before [the effective date of this act].

24	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Severability. If a part of [this act] is invalid, all valid parts that are severable			
25	from the invalid part remain in effect. If a part of [this act] is invalid in one or more of its applications, the part			
26	remains in effect in all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications.

28	NEW SECTION. Section 5. Effective	dates. (1) Except as pro	ovided in subsection (2), [this act] is	
29	effective on passage and approval.
