4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT DESIGNATING MARCH 30 AS WELCOME HOME VIETNAM
5	VETERANS DAY FOR THE STATE OF MONTANA."
6	
7	WHEREAS, the United States became involved in a war in the former Republic of South Vietnam to stop
8	the spread of communism to that country; and
9	WHEREAS, by 1969, a peak of approximately 543,000 members of the armed forces of the United States
10	were serving in the former South Vietnam; and
11	WHEREAS, more than 58,000 members of the armed forces lost their lives in Vietnam and more than
12	300,000 members were wounded; and
13	WHEREAS, by March 30, 1973, combat and combat support units had left Vietnam; and
14	WHEREAS, the Vietnam War was an extremely divisive issue among the people of the United States and
15	caused a generation of veterans to be criticized for participation in a war that was the official policy of four
16	presidential administrations in the United States government, a policy that Vietnam veterans themselves could
17	not control; and
18	WHEREAS, the establishment of a Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day would provide an appreciation
19	that Vietnam veterans deserve for their service but did not receive at the time of their homecoming; and
20	WHEREAS, establishment of a Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day would also promote awareness
21	of the faithful service of Vietnam veterans, promote awareness of their contributions to the country, and recognize
22	the assistance that veterans of the war in Vietnam are providing to the returning veterans of the wars in Iraq and
23	Afghanistan in recovering from their wounds, both seen and unseen, and in supporting the reintegration of these
24	new veterans back into civilian life.

26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
27	
28	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Welcome home Vietnam veterans day. There is established a welcome
29	home Vietnam veterans day for the state of Montana. The welcome home Vietnam veterans day is March 30 of
30	each year and commemorates the day in 1973 when all combat units and combat support units arrived home
