10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Blue aler	t program. (1) T	here is a state alert system known as the blue	
11	alert program within the department of justice.			
12	(2) Upon request by a law enforcement	t agency, the dep	partment may activate the blue alert program if	
13	the department determines that:			
14	(a) a peace officer has been killed or s	eriously injured ir	n the line of duty;	
15	(b) an individual suspected to have cau	used the death or	injury is at large;	
16	(c) a law enforcement agency has determined that the individual referred to in subsection (2)(b) poses			
17	a serious threat to the public, other peace officers, or both; and			
18	(d) sufficient information exists about the	he individual refe	rred to in subsection (2)(b) or about the death	
19	or injury so that the activation of the program would materially assist in the capture of the individual.			
20	(3) Upon activation of the blue alert program, the department shall notify the following entities in the state			
21	or area in which the alert is established:			
22	(a) all law enforcement agencies;			
23	(b) individuals who, because of their	proximity to the	geographic area in which the death or injury	
24	occurred, may have observed the death or injury or the escape of the individual referred to in subsection (2)(b)			
25	or may themselves become a victim of that indi-	vidual;		
26	(c) individuals who may have a special r	elationship to the	individual referred to in subsection (2)(b), such	
27	as a relative of that individual or a peace officer or other person within the criminal justice system who knows the			
28	individual; and			
29	(d) other persons who the department	determines would	d benefit from the notice.	
30	(4) The department shall terminate the	e blue alert when	it determines that the individual referred to in

5	(a) "Law enforcement agency" has the meaning provided in 44-11-303.		
6	(b) "Peace officer" has the meaning provided in 46-1-202.
