Exceptions. (1) Section 45-8-316 does not apply to: 16 (a) any peace officer of the state of Montana or of another state who has the power to make arrests: 17 (b) any officer of the United States government authorized to carry a concealed weapon; 18 (c) a person in actual service as a member of the national guard; 19 (d) a person summoned to the aid of any of the persons named in subsections (1)(a) through (1)(c): 20 (e) a civil officer or the officer's deputy engaged in the discharge of official business; 21 (f) a probation and parole officer authorized to carry a firearm under 46-23-1002; 22 (g) a person eligible to apply for OBTAIN or issued a permit under 45-8-321, or a person with a permit 23 recognized under 45-8-329, OR A PERSON ELIGIBLE TO OBTAIN A PERMIT UNDER 45-8-321 WHO HAS COMPLETED A 24 COURSE AS REQUIRED UNDER 45-8-321(3)(B) OR (3)(C) AND HAS IN THE PERSON'S POSSESSION EVIDENCE OF 25 COMPLETION OF THE COURSE; 26 (h) an agent of the department of justice or a criminal investigator in a county attorney's office; 27 (i) a person who is outside the official boundaries of a city or town or the confines of a logging, lumbering, 28 mining, or railroad camp or who is lawfully engaged in hunting, fishing, trapping, camping, hiking, backpacking, 29 farming, ranching, or other outdoor activity in which weapons are often carried for recreation or protection; or 30 (j) the carrying of arms on one's own premises or at one's home or place of business.
