9	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN		
10	AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 3, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION RECOGNIZING THAT A		
11	PERSON'S INALIENABLE RIGHT TO A CLEAN AND HEALTHFUL ENVIRONMENT INCLUDES THE RIGHT

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:		
16			
17	Section 1. Article II, section 3, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:		
18	"Section 3. Inalienable rights. All persons are born free and have certain inalienable rights. They		
19	include the right to a clean, and healthful, and economically productive environment and the rights of pursuing		
20	life's basic necessities, enjoying and defending their lives and liberties, acquiring, possessing and protecting		
21	property, and seeking their safety, health and happiness in all lawful ways. In enjoying these rights, all persons		
22	recognize corresponding responsibilities."

24	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal		
25	to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote		
26	of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage.

28	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective upon approval of the electorate.

30	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified
