8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 39-51-2105, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"39-51-2105. Qualifying wages. To qualify for benefits, an individual:
12	(1) must have been paid total wages for employment in the base period in an amount:
13	(1)(a) not less than 1 1/2 times the wages earned in the calendar quarter in which wages were the
14	highest during the base period; however, the total wages in the base period must be equal to or greater than 7%
15	of the average annual wage described in 39-51-2201; or
16	(2)(b) equal to or greater than 50% of the average annual wage described in 39-51-2201; and
17	(2) must have been employed during each week of the base period or a portion of each week of the base
18	period. An individual may not have more than 7 work days in which the individual was not employed during the
19	base period."
