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4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN
5	AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X, SECTION 9, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION REQUIRING THE ELECTION
6	OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC EDUCATION AND REDUCING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS; AND PROVIDING
7	AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN APPLICABILITY DATE."
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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	Section 1. Article X, section 9, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:
12	"Section 9. Boards of education. (1) There is a state board of education composed of the board of
13	regents of higher education and the board of public education. It is responsible for long-range planning, and for
14	coordinating and evaluating policies and programs for the state's educational systems. It shall submit unified
15	budget requests. A tie vote at any meeting may be broken by the governor, who is an ex officio member of each
16	component board.
17	(2) (a) The government and control of the Montana university system is vested in a board of regents of
18	higher education which shall have full power, responsibility, and authority to supervise, coordinate, manage and
19	control the Montana university system and shall supervise and coordinate other public educational institutions
20	assigned by law.
21	(b) The board consists of seven members appointed by the governor, and confirmed by the senate, to
22	overlapping terms, as provided by law. The governor and superintendent of public instruction are ex officio
23	non-voting members of the board.
24	(c) The board shall appoint a commissioner of higher education and prescribe his term and duties.
25	(d) The funds and appropriations under the control of the board of regents are subject to the same audit
26	provisions as are all other state funds.
27	(3) (a) There is a board of public education to exercise general supervision over the public school system
28	and such other public educational institutions as may be assigned by law. Other duties of the board shall be
29	provided by law.
30	(b) The board consists of seven five members appointed by the governor, and confirmed by the senate,

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to overlapping terms elected as provided by law. The governor, commissioner of higher education and state superintendent of public instruction shall be ex officio non-voting members of the board."

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NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date -- applicability. If approved by the electorate, this amendment is effective January 1, 2013, and applies to the election to be held in November 2014.

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 3. Two-thirds vote required.** Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage.

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NEW SECTION. Section 4. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2012 by printing on the ballot the full title of [this act] and the following:

- [] FOR electing members of the board of public education and reducing the number of members.
- 15 [] AGAINST electing members of the board of public education and reducing the number of members.
