9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 50-46-205, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"50-46-205. Limitations of Medical Marijuana Act. (1) This chapter does not permit:
13	(a) any person to operate, navigate, or be in actual physical control of any motor vehicle, aircraft, or
14	motorboat while under the influence of marijuana;
15	(b) the use of marijuana by a caregiver; or
16	(c) the smoking <u>use</u> of marijuana by a qualifying patient:
17	(i) in a school bus or other form of public transportation;
18	(ii) on any school grounds;
19	(iii) in any correctional facility; or
20	(iv) at any public park, public beach, public recreation center, or youth center: or
21	(v) in plain view of the public.
22	(2) A qualifying patient who has a valid registry identification card may smoke marijuana only in the
23	qualifying patient's residence. The patient may not smoke the marijuana in the presence of children.
24	(2)(3) Nothing in this chapter may be construed to require:
25	(a) a government medical assistance program or private health insurer to reimburse a person for costs
26	associated with the medical use of marijuana; or
27	(b) an employer to accommodate the medical use of marijuana in any workplace.
28	(3)(4) Nothing in this chapter may be construed to allow a caregiver to use marijuana or to prevent
29	criminal prosecution of a caregiver who uses marijuana or paraphernalia for the caregiver's personal use."
