10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:	
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12	Section 1. Article VIII, section 9, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:	
13	"Section 9. Balanced budget and spending limit. (1) Appropriations by the legislature shall not exceed	
14	anticipated revenue and are subject to a state spending limit prohibiting appropriations for a biennium of a total	
15	amount of money that is more than the state spending limit.	
16	(2) The state spending limit is the amount of money appropriated in the prior biennium plus the	
17	appropriation growth factor.	
18	(3) The appropriation growth factor is the sum of one-half the average rate of inflation for the prior 3	
19	years plus one-half the average growth in population in the state for the prior 3 years multiplied by the amount	
20	of money appropriated in the prior biennium. The average rate of inflation must be calculated using the consumer	
21	price index or its successor index as published by the United States. The average growth in population in the	
22	state must be calculated using available information as published by the United States.	
23	(4) For purposes of the state spending limit calculation, legislative appropriations shall include all	
24	legislative appropriations during the biennium except the following categories:	
25	(a) money from the federal government;	
26	(b) payments of principal and interest on bonded indebtedness;	
27	(c) money for unemployment or disability insurance benefits;	
28	(d) money from the sale of goods or services provided that the purchase of the goods or services is	
29	discretionary;	
30	(e) money from permanent endowments, constitutional trusts, or pension funds;

1	(f) grants, gifts, devises, or bequests made to the state;		
2	(g) money appropriated for tax relief; and		
3	3 (h) funds transferred within the state treasure	or used to purchase goods for resale."

5	5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective upon approval of the electorate.

7	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualifie		
8	electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2012 by printing on the ballot the full title		
9	[this act] and the following:		
10	10 [] FOR limiting an increase in appropria	tions to the combined growth factor of one-half the rate of	
11	inflation plus one-half the rate of pop	ulation growth.	
12	12 [] AGAINST limiting an increase in app	ropriations to the combined growth factor of one-half the	
13	rate of inflation plus one-half the rate	of population growth.
